

Parklane Gallery is Kirkland's only artist-owned gallery. It was established in 1991 by a group of artists wishing to exhibit and sell their work in Kirkland's artistic downtown community. The enterprise has grown and includes a gallery and private studio spaces.

Parklane Gallery looks forward to further growth and diversification, embracing a wider variety of artistic media and creative work.

Each of the artists of Parklane Gallery is an owner of the business. The gallery artists include established and emerging painters, sculptors, and photographers in all media and styles ranging from abstract to representational. Each member artist was juried by the other artists and pays a monthly fee for wall or floor space. The allotted spaces are rotated monthly, to ensure fairness and all are encouraged to display new work at these intervals.

Each month Parklane Gallery's front sections display two featured artist exhibitions. Individual members take turns appearing in this position. Every January the gallery features the All Member show and in May, Parklane Gallery hosts a renowned International Annual Juried Miniature Art Show.

The gallery maintains a web site, on which a sampling of each artist's work and contact information may be found.

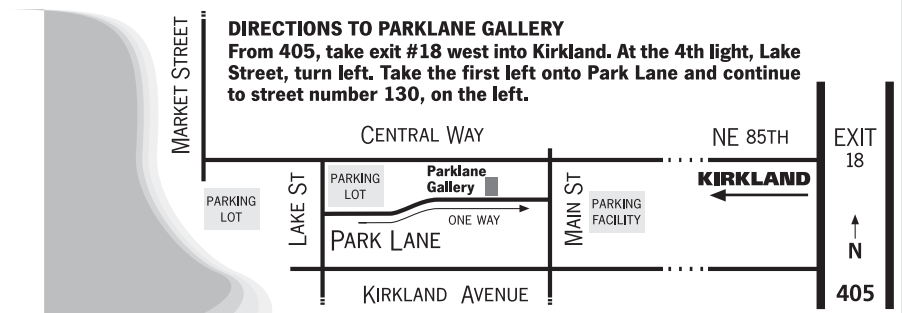

Parklane Gallery Membership Information

Parklane is an artist-owned gallery. The gallery commission for work sold is 20%. Everyone is encouraged to participate in Art Walk occurring on the 2nd Thursday of each month. The time spent working at the gallery and attending meetings is a good time for artists to promote the gallery and themselves.

Application Instructions

1. Provide the membership committee with 3 photographs or digital images of your best work, along with the completed application form and an inventory list indicating title, medium, size and retail price of each piece. Do not submit original art at this time.

2. The membership committee will review your application and contact you. For the jury process, artists will be required to bring five original art works representative of what would be shown in the gallery. At that time, please be prepared to speak ten minutes about why you became an artist, your background and information about your art. Please be prepared to respond to artist's questions about your art.

Funds needed upon acceptance:

\$85.00 - First Month Rent / \$85.00 - Last Month Rent / \$100.00 Non Refundable Entrance Fee / \$20 Refundable Key Deposit / \$50 Kirkland Business License. Total = \$340.00

Membership Requirements:

Each new member must:

1. Sign a six month contract
2. Work two sales shifts per month
3. Serve on at least one committee
4. Assist the Curatorial Committee for the first two months
5. Abide by the By-Laws
6. Attend General Meetings
7. Attend ArtWalk regularly
