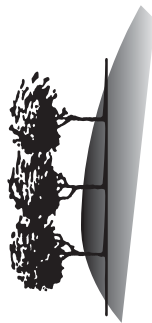


Parklane Gallery is Kirkland's only artist-owned gallery. It was established in 1991 by a group of artists who wanted to exhibit and sell their work in Kirkland's artistic downtown community. The enterprise has grown and includes a gallery and private studio spaces.

Parklane Gallery looks forward to further growth and diversification, embracing a wider variety of artistic media and types of creative work.

Each of the thirty-plus artists of Parklane Gallery is an owner of the business. The gallery artists include established and emerging painters, sculptors, and photographers in all media and in all styles ranging from abstract to representational. Each was juried by the other artists to be initially accepted and pays a monthly fee for wall and floor space. The allotted spaces are rotated monthly, to ensure fairness, and all are encouraged to display new work at these (or any) intervals.

Every month Parklane Gallery's front section and street window displays two featured artist exhibitions. The individual members take turns in this position, or the feature may be a group show. Every summer Parklane Gallery features a renowned International Annual Juried Miniature Art Show.

Parklane Gallery advertises in the local print media, and participates in the promotional activities of downtown Kirkland, such as the well-known monthly Art Walks. Each gallery artist is assured of display space during Gallery open hours and, being an owner, has access to the gallery for private or special showings of his/her work at any time.

The gallery maintains a web site, on which a sampling of each artist's work and contact information may be found.

In addition to these benefits, the members enjoy the satisfaction of association with fellow artists. There is a monthly meeting during which members gather to talk shop, enjoy presentations, review each other's new and unfinished work, and enjoy professional fellowship.

Membership obligations, in addition to the monthly fee, involve sharing work at the sales desk as a volunteer and participation in meetings and other functions needed to operate the business. Recognizing that gallery artists have already paid for their exhibition space, only 15% commission is retained by the Gallery on sales.
